**Getting There and Around:**

Alaska Wildland Adventures' Guided Journey and Lodge packages start in Anchorage or Fairbanks. Call our experienced reservations specialists for details on each trip. During an AWA adventure, guests may travel by raft, touring kayak, foot, cruise yacht, deluxe 20-passenger mini-bus, 15-passenger van and the Alaska Railroad.

**Age/ Fitness Requirements:**

Average physical condition is all that is needed to enjoy an AWA Guided Journey or Lodge Package. Participants should be comfortable walking 3-4 hours steadily with short breaks. Family trips cater to families with children between the ages of 6-12. Other AWA trips require that guests be at least twelve years of age.

**Climate:**

June - September, day temperatures average 60-75°F; night temperatures average 40-60°F. Occasional light rain can be expected, though sunny days generally prevail.
