Built to Celebrate and Respect Kenai Fjords National Park

The unique location of Kenai Fjords Glacier Lodge offers guests an unparalleled vantage point of Kenai Fjords National Park. A stay at the lodge begins with a marine wildlife and glacier cruise; departing from the charming town of Seward, guests tour the dramatic coastline and massive glaciers, seeking out whales, Dall's porpoises, Steller sea lions, harbor seals, sea otters, puffins and more along the way. Upon arrival, a short walk (or ride) leads to the lodge and cabins, each built with sensitivity to the surrounding environment. The lodge and guest cabins reside within the Native-owned, 1,700+ acre Pedersen Lagoon Wildlife Sanctuary. These heritage lands, owned by Port Graham Corporation (PGC), an Alaska Native Village Corporation, represent a small portion of the ancestral homeland of the Alutiiq people that once lived along and roamed the entire coast of Southcentral Alaska. Lodge activities emphasize appreciative exploration of the park; guests may choose from guided sea kayaking, guided or unguided explorations on foot, taking part in naturalist programs or simply strolling along the miles of pristine beachfront.
